XVIII Math Kangaroo Olympiad takes place on March 19, 2015 in 38 US states and 2 US territories.

21,000 American students participate along with over 6,000,000 other participants worldwide. The competition has the form of a multiple choice test to be solved within 75 minutes. There are 12 levels of participation, corresponding to school grade levels. The objective is to encourage children and teenagers to master mathematical skills.

In USA there are gifts, t-shirts and certificates of participation for all competitors. Gift cards, books, puzzles, and international summer camps are among the awards for the top achievers. The event takes place in about 450 classrooms, libraries, and other places in USA where the test is followed with fun activities: from group photos to pizza parties, from an all-day Math Fest in Guam to a presentation of World Class Master of Storytelling, Ryan Avery, in Hillsboro, OR.
