Over one hundred countries are part of the international Kangaroo math coalition, with roughly 6 million students participating in their countries' competitions every year!

Mathematics is an important foundation for all scientific and technical subjects and is invaluable in developing the logic that applies to other disciplines as well. It is more important than ever to invest in children's education. We hope you join us in helping students grow in their analytical abilities and skills in the classroom.

About Us

Math Kangaroo USA focuses on helping students improve their math performance by teaching new strategies for solving word and logic problems. The program fosters critical thinking and builds confidence that extends beyond the competition and into the classroom.

Our History

Math Kangaroo USA began in 1998 in Chicago. In 2003, it was officially registered as a not-for-profit organization with the mission of planning and promoting the competition nationwide.

What We Do

For the last 28 years, Math Kangaroo USA has hosted an annual international mathematical competition for thousands of K–12 students. The 75-minute test encourages creative thinking and strengthens advanced problem-solving skills through engaging, non-routine problems. In addition to the competition, Math Kangaroo USA provides a wide range of resources to help students prepare and deepen their mathematical understanding.

How We're Helping Students

Math Kangaroo Competition

We host the Math Kangaroo competition on the third Thursday of March every year. Students complete 24-30 problems requiring them to think creatively and critically. Each participant receives a ribbon/ bookmark, small prizes, and a certificate for participating.

Math Kangaroo Awards

We understand the importance of focusing less on the competitive aspect of the Math Kangaroo competition and more on the collective sense of accomplishment participants feel. We host Math Kangaroo award ceremonies across the country so participants can celebrate their achievements alongside their friends and family. As part of the awards, we also highlight top scorers and distribute scholarships to graduating seniors who have participated in the competition over several years.

Individual & Group Coaching

We provide coaching on a group and individual basis and preparatory classes for students looking for additional support and instruction year-round the competition.

Practice Resources for Students

Math Kangaroo USA provides books and free resources for students looking for additional practice and support while preparing for the Math Kangaroo competition. We also post weekly video questions and collaborate with other organizations to provide Live-Solve events and educational webinars.

Lesson Plans for Teachers

Math Kangaroo USA provides free lesson plans to teachers and homeschooling parents who offer competition preparation to students free of charge. Our lesson plans consist of creative math and logic questions, similar to those students will encounter during the competition, with instructions on how to solve them.

Math Kangaroo USA has a presence in all 50 states and several U.S. territories. We are committed to serving all K–12 students, regardless of their current math level, by supporting their growth, encouraging learning, and fostering a lifelong appreciation for mathematics.

Our Enrollment


Since our founding in 1998, Math Kangaroo USA has served close to 500,000 students, helping them strengthen their logic and critical thinking skills while improving their math performance.



Bringing Math Kangaroo to Your School

Schools have the option to open a Math Kangaroo center and host the competition either on paper or using school computers. A minimum of 10 enrolled students is required to establish a center. The competition can be coordinated by a teacher, a school administrator, or a PTA parent.

In recognition of their efforts, local organizers may be eligible for end-of-season benefits or acknowledgment. Participation fees can be paid by parents or fully covered by the school, helping to make the competition more accessible to a broader group of students.

Participation Rates:

School Rate- \$18 per student

Title I School Rate- \$9 per student (Eligible for free participation. Contact us for more information.)
