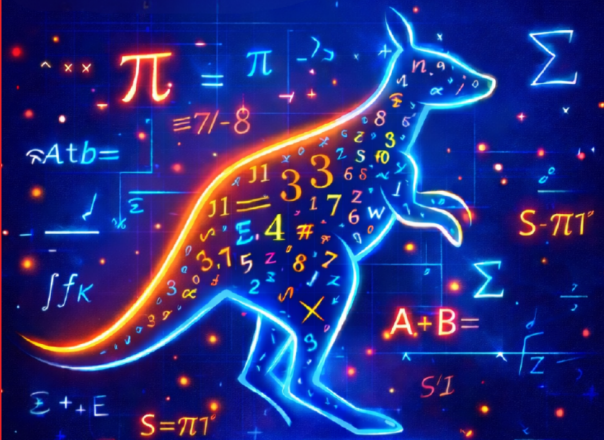

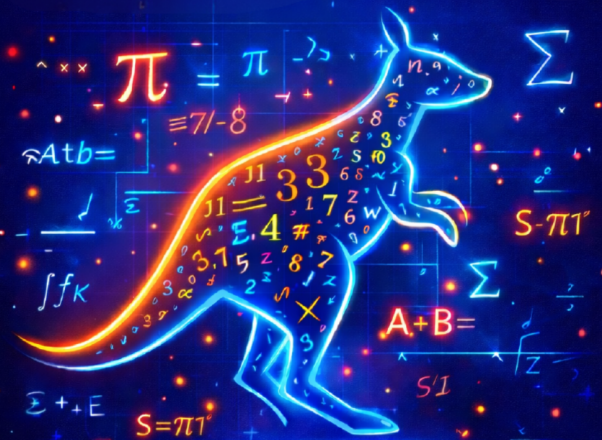

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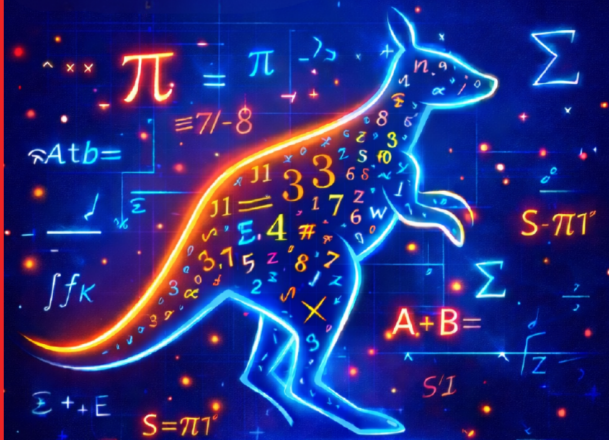
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MATH KANGAROO TEAM COMPETITION FOR K-12 STUDENTS

NOVEMBER 13–20, 2026

 60-minute team test

 Test includes:

- 24 questions for grades 1–4:
 - 16 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ)
 - 8 Short Answer Questions (SAQ)
- 30 questions for grades 5–12:
 - 20 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ)
 - 10 Short Answer Questions (SAQ)

 Questions include engaging word problems and are carefully selected each year by the International Math Kangaroo Committee to challenge teams' problem-solving skills.

 Team Format:

- Teams consist of 2–4 students
- Teams compete in the division of their highest-grade member
- Each team is supported by an adult Coach, who forms and registers the team, and led by a student Captain, who submits the team's answers.
- Collaboration is allowed within each team only

 Every participant receives:

- A Math Kangaroo ribbon
- An electronic certificate of participation

 Top performers may receive:

- Trophies
 - Medals & Certificates (Top 3 National)
 - Certificates of Excellence
 - Math Kangaroo Pins State Winners
