Math Kangaroo High School Summer Research Program – Nomination Criteria

The Math Kangaroo Wolfram High School Summer Research Program is a **two-week in-person research experience** designed for highly motivated high school students with strong mathematical ability and interest in advanced problem-solving and computational thinking.

Math Kangaroo will **nominate and recommend up to two students** each year for this program and will **provide full sponsorship upon acceptance by the program organizers**.

Eligibility Criteria

Nominees will be selected based on outstanding performance in Math Kangaroo individual competitions, including:

- Maintained a **top 3 ranking** (1st, 2nd, or 3rd) nationally **at least three times** in recent years (**6th-10th grade**).
- Demonstrated **consistent participation** in the Math Kangaroo competition.
- In the event the selected student cannot utilize the award, we will seek the next best candidate.

Program Purpose

This initiative aims to support exceptional students in advancing their mathematical thinking through an immersive research experience and exposure to computational and theoretical problem-solving. Final acceptance is determined by the Wolfram Summer Research Program admissions team. Upon acceptance, Math Kangaroo will provide full sponsorship for the selected students.
