Math Kangaroo Middle School Asia Camp Criteria

The Math Kangaroo Asia Summer Camp is a **six-day program held in Boao, Hainan Island, China, for Grades 6–8 students**. Each season, about **2,000 Math Kangaroo high achievers from around the world** gather for academic challenges, collaboration, and cultural exchange. The program includes **four days of math activities** such as problem-solving challenges, presentations, a Math Bazaar, and an Advanced Round featuring individual and team competitions, while also offering opportunities to learn from mathematicians and coaches and develop teamwork and leadership skills.

Each season, up to **16 students** are selected and invited. This is a **partially sponsored** program: Math Kangaroo covers camp fees and accommodations, while families cover travel expenses.

To qualify for the **Math Kangaroo Asia Camp**, candidates must meet the following criteria:

- Achieved a **Top 10 national ranking** in Grade 6, 7, or 8 during the current individual competition season.
- Participated in the **Math Kangaroo individual competition at least three times within the past four years**.
- **Submitted the application** by the deadline indicated in the official invitation.
- Final selections will be made from invited applicants based on **their individual competition performance this season and their achievements in previous years**.
- If a selected student is unable to accept the award, the opportunity will be offered to the **next best-qualified candidate**.

The Math Kangaroo Asia Summer Camp is designed to **recognize and support exceptional middle school students** who demonstrate a strong passion for mathematics. It aims to inspire and empower them to continue developing their skills and deepen their engagement in the field of mathematics.
